Training

- All coaches are required to be accredited.
- Committee, coaches and team managers must have a working with children check from Victoria.
- Junior and Senior Training will commence around February, usually Tuesday, Wednesday and/or Thursday nights across ages between 4pm to 8.30pm, your coach or team manager will let you know your times by email/telephone or check Facebook.
- Make sure that children have appropriate sportswear, shin guards, check that boots fit properly. Bring water, towel and wear sunscreen and bring medical requirements as necessary.
- Parents are welcome to stay and assist the coach with training such as setting up and packing up of equipment and getting involved with exercises etc.
- Let the coach know if you are unable to attend training and relevant medical conditions.

Game Day

- The Annual Draw will be sent out once finalised by AWFA
- Ground Directions are on the website www.myrtlefordsoccer.com.au
- Arrive at least ½ hour before your game is scheduled make sure you have the coaches/team manager contact number. Give the coach plenty of notice if you are not going to be available on the day
- Once washed place all your sports wear in your bag, include first aid items, sunscreen, hat, towel, change of clothes and tape for your socks.
- Make sure that you have an appropriate water container for your needs
- Include some Gatorade or Powerade (buy from supermarket and make up cheaper option) in a separate container.
- Bring along some healthy snacks to keep up your energy levels especially if playing an extra game.
- Before you leave the house make sure you have all your gear in your bag

Soccer Gear

- Med to Large Bag to hold your gear
- Tops are supplied by the Club and are the team managers responsibility
- Shorts and socks along with other club merchandise can be ordered from the club under merchandise at www.myrtlefordsoccer.com.au or at club rooms
- Purchase or check your footwear, shin guards and mouth guards as necessary
- Water containers (inside outback drink esky)
